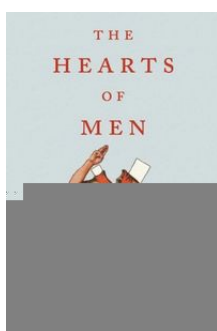


THE HEARTS OF MEN
