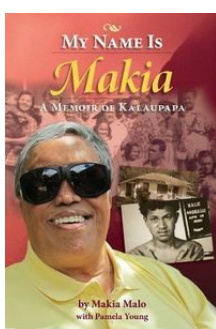


# MY NAME IS MAKIA: A MEMOIR OF KALAUPAPA
